



- Caps and gowns are worn to both commencement and convocation ceremonies. Gowns should be zipped.
- Tassels are worn on the left.

Arriving at Graduation Ceremonies

- With multiple events scheduled across campus, limited parking is available and carpooling is encouraged. Allow ample time to reach your destination.
- For the convocation ceremonies in the Music Building (on Friday, April 26), graduates and guests will enter through different doors (see the map at right).
